## Responsibility Code for Kids

This version of the snowsports industry's responsibility code is written with kids in mind. It is adapted from the National Ski Areas Association's "Your Responsibility Code."

1. Always be able to turn or stop to stay in control.
2. Leave room between yourself and other people when skiing or riding.
3. Stop on the side of the run where others can see you.
4. When starting from a stop, or wherever trails meet, look uphill. Let other people go first.
5. Don't let your skis or snowboard slide away from you.
6. Obey all signs. Don't go under ropes or into areas that are closed.
7. Be careful on the lift. Sit down. Sit back. Sit still. Ask for help if you need it.

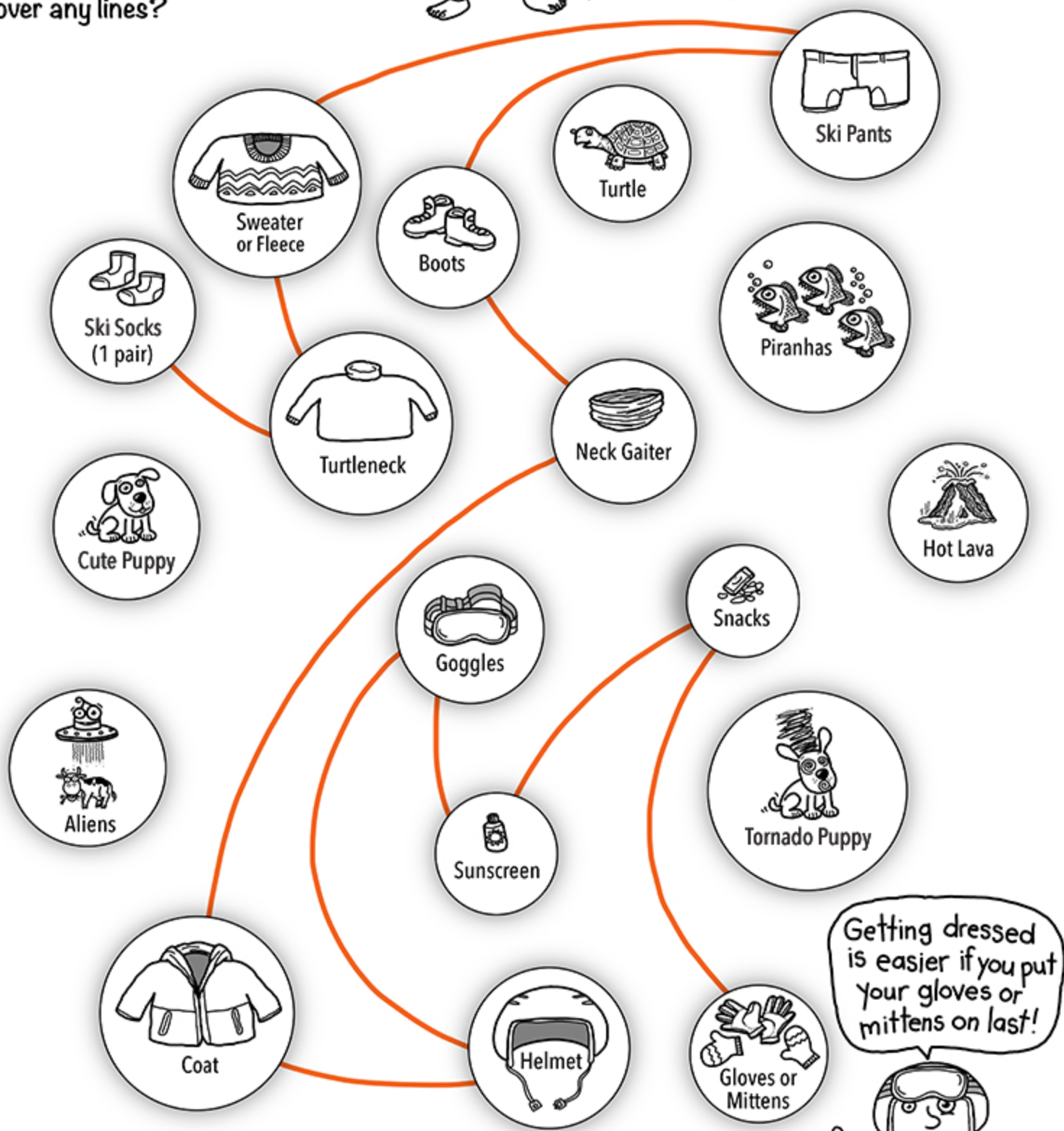
It's a beautiful day to go snowboarding...but some things look a little odd here.



## Shhh - Here's an Expert Secret!

Going straight downhill makes you go fast. *Anyone* can do that. **A** watermelon can do that! That doesn't make the **w**atermelon **a** good skier or snowboarder.

Did **y**ou know that the **best** skiers and riders can go fast, slow down, and stop anytime and anywhere? Do you want to know their secret?



They control their speed **by** the shape of their turns! Go downhill and feel the speed, then *turn across the hill* and feel yourself slow down. Try turning so much that you go uphill to a stop!

Remember, *anyone* can go fast, **but** really good skiers and riders always **control** their speed by making **turns** that let them decide **how** fast they should go! **Remember**, turning to a **stop** means you are in control!

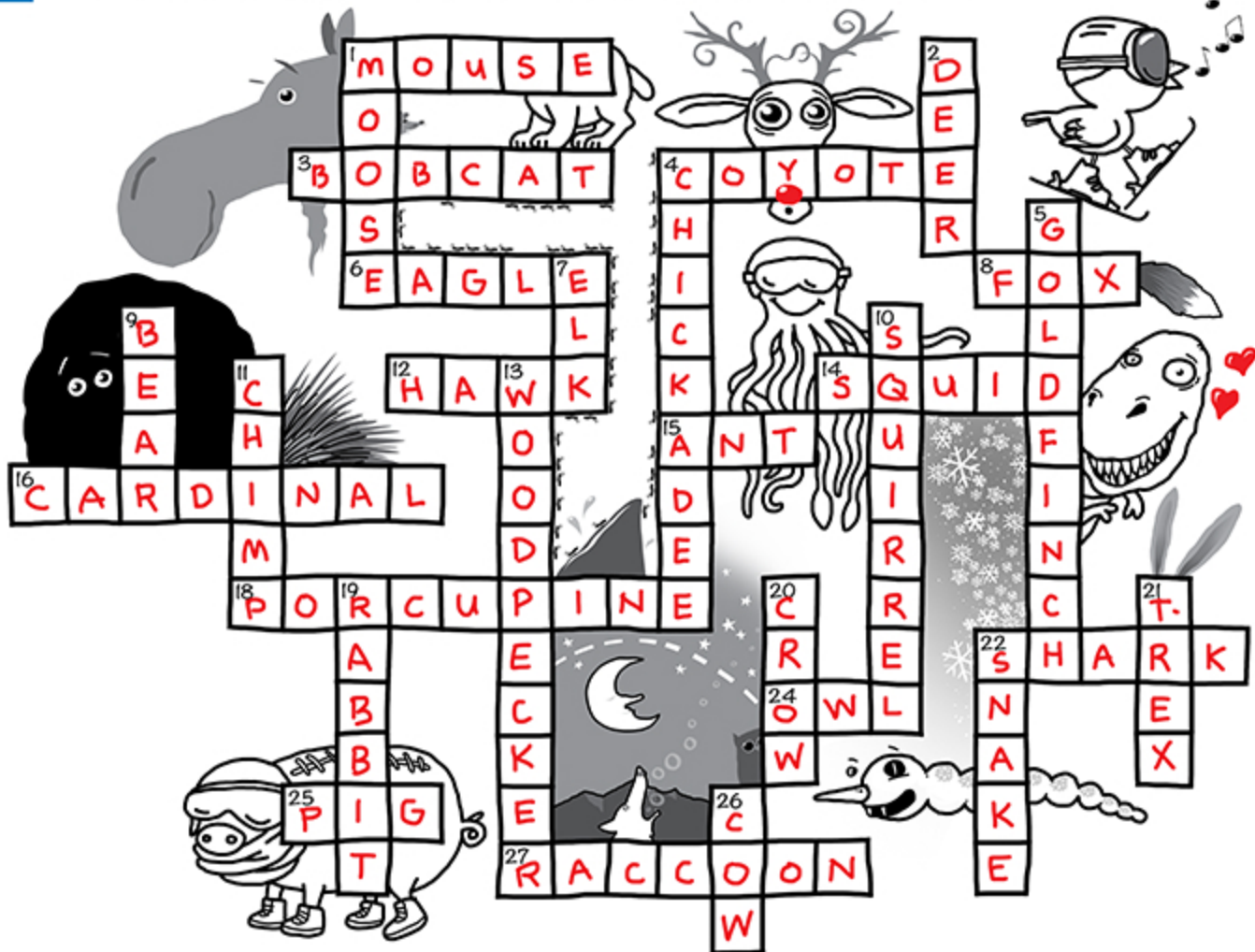
