## Responsibility Code for Kids

This version of the snowsports industry's responsibility code is written with kids in mind. It is adapted from the National Ski Areas Association's "Your Responsibility Code."


- 1. Always be able to turn or stop to stay in control.
- Leave room between yourself and other people when skiing or riding.
- Stop on the side of the run where others can see you.
- When starting from a stop, or wherever trails meet, look uphill. Let other people go first.
- Don't let your skis or snowboard slide away from you.
- Obey all signs. Don't go under ropes or into areas that are closed.
- Be careful on the lift. Sit down. Sit back. Sit still. Ask for help if you need it.



### Can you find all the green words in the word search?




What do you call a snow alligator in a vest?





The kids found a snow cave. What's this? A message on the walls! What does it say?






It's a beautiful day to go snowboarding...but some things look a little odd here. How many can you find?
